BPD Commits Additional Resources to Crack Down on Heroin Dealers

During the last several weeks Cape Cod communities have experienced people overdosing on heroin at an extraordinary level. The Barnstable Police Department has committed additional manpower and resources in an attempt to stem the tide of illegal heroin being sold in Barnstable and arrest people involved in the distribution of heroin.

For the last several weeks the Barnstable Police Narcotics Unit conducted an investigation relating to the distribution of heroin in and around Hyannis by a subject identified as Kristoffer W Marciezyk, age 29, of West Barnstable. On 12/09/2014, Barnstable Police Narcotics Detectives executed a narcotics search warrant on room #14 at the Craigsville Motel, 8 Shoot Flying Hill Road, West Barnstable. Present in the room was MARCIEZYK and Alicia Kelley, age 26, of West Barnstable.

A search of the room and its occupants resulted in the recovery of 10 grams of heroin on the person of MARCIEZYK, several suboxone tablets, drug paraphernalia, and \$218.00 in US currency. Both MARCIEZYK and KELLEY were placed under arrest and charged with the following:

MARCIEZYK Poss of class A/heroin with intent to distribute
Poss of class B/suboxone

KELLEY Knowing being present where heroin is kept

Both were transported to the Barnstable Police Department and arraigned in Barnstable District Court on 12/10/2014.

Also for the last several months members of the Barnstable Police Department Narcotics Unit, Barnstable Street Crime Unit, Cape Cod Drug Task Force, and Yarmouth Police Department conduct a joint investigation focusing on Collin J Peters, age 19, of Hyannis. PETERS is known

to law enforcement. He currently has a case pending in Barnstable District Court for poss with intent to distribute heroin and illegal possession of a firearm.

PETERS was suspected of being involved in the distribution of heroin in the Mid-Cape area especially in and around Cromwell Court, 168 Barnstable Road, Hyannis. On 12/10/2014 an arrest warrant charging PETERS with distribution of class A/heroin was obtained in Barnstable District Court. A narcotics search warrant was also obtained for the apartment PETERS was staying at in Cromwell Courts. Surveillance was initiated around the apartment complex in an attempt to locate PETERS outside the apartment. At approximately 1619 hours, PETERS was observed walking in the parking lot of Quantum Communications of Cape Cod, 154 Barnstable Road, Hyannis. Members of the surveillance group approached PETERS and attempted to place him under arrest for the outstanding arrest warrant. PETERS refused to comply and physically resisted. A taser was deployed and PETERS was eventually secured with handcuffs. At the time of his arrest PETERS was wearing a backpack. A search of the backpack revealed in contained over 30 grams of heroin and over \$1100 US currency. PETERS was transported back to the Barnstable Police Department.

The surveillance unit executed the search warrant at apartment #2J in Cromwell Courts. Present at the time inside the apartment was an adult female and her three (3) small children. The search resulted in the recovery of approximately eighty (80) prescription pills and drug paraphernalia.

PETERS was charged with the following:

- Disorderly person
- Resisting arrest
- Trafficking in heroin
- Distribution of class A/heroin-warrant
- Poss with intent to distribute class C/clonazepam
- Poss with intent to distribute class E/tramadol

He will be arraigned in Barnstable District Court on Thursday 12/11/2014.

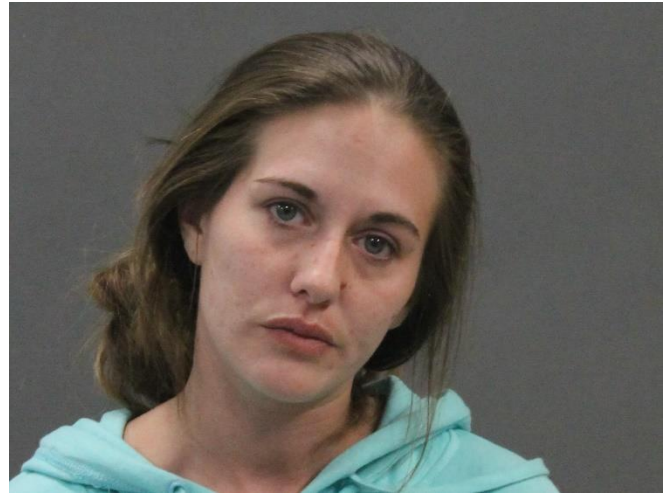
