Three Arrested for Distribution of Heroin at the Shanghai Restaurant

During the last three (3) months, the Barnstable Street Crime Unit (SCU) conducted an investigation into the distribution of heroin and cocaine from inside the Shanghai restaurant, 11 Ridgewood Avenue, Hyannis. The investigation revealed that numerous subjects involved in the distribution of narcotics in and around Hyannis were frequenting the Shanghai restaurant. The drug sales many times were very blatant and out in the open. The SCU made twelve (12) narcotics purchases inside the restaurant involving eight (8) subjects. All the subjects were known to area law enforcement and suspected of being involved in drug distribution.

On 12/19/2014, the SCU obtained arrest warrants for the subjects involved. A multi jurisdiction arrest team comprised of the Barnstable Police Department, Mashpee Police Department, Yarmouth Police Department, Mass State Police, and Barnstable County Sheriff's Department responded to the Shanghai restaurant in an attempt to locate the wanted subjects. Two (2) people were located and arrested on the outstanding warrants at the restaurant. Sherman Anderson, age 36, of Hyannis was arrested on a warrant charging him with two (2) counts of distribution of cocaine subsequent offense. S. ANDERSON has several previous convictions for the distribution of cocaine and is currently on probation. At the time of his arrest, S. Anderson was found in possession of approximately three (3) grams of cocaine. He was additionally charged with possession of class B/cocaine substance with the intent to distribute. Marcus W. McDowell, age 23, of Hyannis was arrested and charged with one (1) count of distribution of cocaine. At the time of his arrest he was found in possession of marijuana. He was subsequently charged with possession of class D/marijuana substance with intent to distribute.

The Dennis Police Department was able to locate Madison J. Bohanna, age 41, of Hyannis. He was arrested on an outstanding warrant for two (2) counts of distribution of class B/cocaine from inside the Shanghai. All three (3) are currently being held at the Barnstable Police Department on bail. They will be arraigned in Barnstable District Court on Monday 12/22/2014. The investigation is ongoing and additional arrests are expected.
