Barnstable SCU Makes Four Narcotics Related Arrests Include a Violent Felon

The first weekend in April turned out to be a very busy one for the Barnstable Street Crime Unit (SCU). SCU made four narcotics related arrests included in the four was a person convicted of a 2009 armed robbery in Boston. They also arrested a subject on a warrant for failure to register as a sex offender. One of the primary duties of the SCU is to suppress and deter the sale and use of narcotics in and around Towns of Barnstable, Yarmouth, and Mashpee. On 04/05/2012, members of the SCU were deployed to the area around the Town Green in Hyannis. The Town Green is located in downtown Hyannis area. SCU and Barnstable Police Department Patrol Units frequently patrol the Town Green in an effort to deter public drinking, narcotics use, and other quality of life crimes. On this date, at 6:30pm an SCU member observed a group of eight (8) subjects congregated around a bench in the Town Green center. A surveillance of the group was initiated. Many of the groups were known to the SCU as homeless. Several group members appeared to be consuming alcohol. SCU encountered the subjects. All but one in the group identified themselves as homeless. Three (3) people were placed under arrest. They were identified and charged with:

Jonathan M Kett, age 38, homeless

1. Consuming alcohol in public-Town of Barnstable by law

John F Lyons, age 50, homeless

1. Consuming alcohol in public-Town of Barnstable by law
2. Illegal possession of class E substance

Patrick M Hannan, age 48, of Centerville

1. Illegal possession of class E substance
2. Illegal possession of class E substance
3. Illegal possession of class D/marijuana under ounce-civil offense

All three were transported to the Barnstable Police Department, booked, and later release on bail for their arraignment in Barnstable District Court on Monday April 8th.

On 04/05/2013, SCU members Barnstable Officer Keith Sexton and Barnstable Deputy Kim Saladino were on patrol in the Hyannis area. At approximately 9:00pm they were driving on Rte 28 in the area of Bearses Way, Hyannis. They encountered a vehicle operating very erratically. The vehicle was a grey Jeep Wrangler being operated by Bridget Callahan, age 25, of Centerville. CALLAHAN's made an illegal right hand turn almost causing a collision with SEXTON's and SALADINO's unmarked SCU patrol vehicle. CALLAHAN's vehicle was stopped and evidence of marijuana use was observed.

CALLAHAN appeared to have recently smoked marijuana. She had remnants of marijuana on her clothing. A field sobriety test was conducted which CALLAHAN failed. CALLAHAN was placed under arrest and charged with the following:

1. OUI-Drugs/marijuana
2. Operating to endanger
3. Improper right turn

She was transported to the Barnstable Police Department, booked, and subsequently bailed for her arraignment in Barnstable District Court on Monday April 8th.

SCU members Barnstable Officer Scott Wright and Yarmouth Nicholas Ambrosini developed information related to a person wanted for failure to register as a sex offender. A warrant had been issued for Quinn A Saffold, age 45, of Hyannis. SAFFOLD is well known to area law enforcement. In July of 2009, he was convicted in Barnstable Superior Court for possession with intent to distribute cocaine-subsequent offense. He was given a three (3) year sentence in State Prison. On 04/06/2013 at 8:50pm, WRIGHT and AMBROSINI located SAFFOLD at 14 Summer Lane, Hyannis. He was placed under arrest for the outstanding warrant and booked at the Barnstable Police Department. SAFFOLD was released on personal recognize bail for his arraignment at Barnstable District Court on Monday April 8th. .

On 04/06/2013, members of the SCU received information from a confidential source that Jason Battles was in the Hyannis area and in possession of narcotics. BATTLES, age 37, of Pawtucket, RI has a lengthy criminal history. He was convicted in November 2009 in Suffolk Superior Court in Boston for a May 2009 armed robbery. He was sentenced to two (2) years in States Prison. BATTLES criminal history dates back to 1993 with numerous convictions for

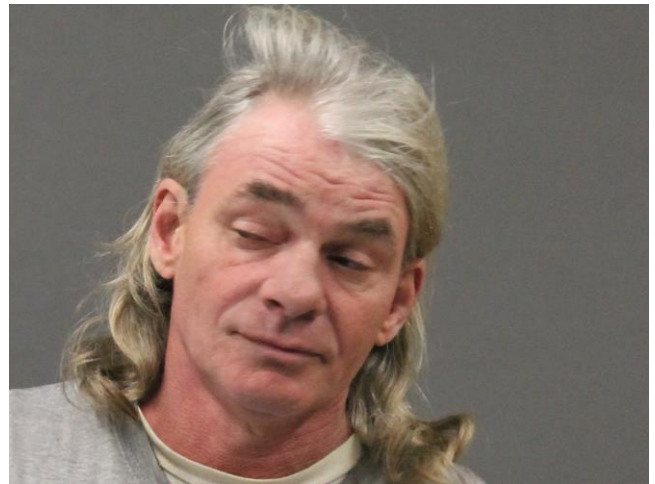

A&B with dangerous weapon and A&B. On 04/07/2013, at 12:30am SCU members located BATTLES and his vehicle, a 1988 Ford Thunderbird, in the parking lot of the Rte/Rte 132 Burger King. SCU members encountered BATTLES based on the information they received. He was found in possession of fifteen (15) grams of cocaine, one (1) gram of heroin, and \$700 cash. He was placed under arrest and charged with possession with intent to distribute A/heroin & B/cocaine. BATTLES was booked at the Barnstable Police Department and is currently being held on a \$3000 cash bail

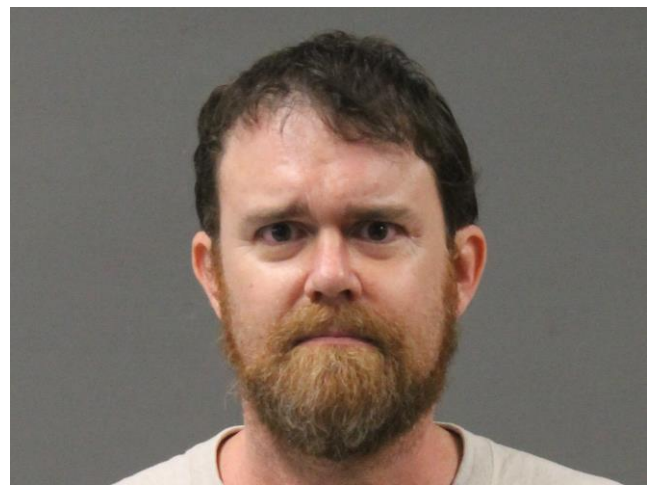
