## **Barnstable Police Department Press Release**

March 29th, 2013

### **Busy Weekend for the Street Crimes Unit**

On 03/29/2013, Members of the Barnstable Police Street Crime Unit (SCU) were working in the Hyannis area. The SCU had received information from a confidential source about the occupants of a vehicle driving around Hyannis attempting to purchase heroin. The driver was reportedly from Brewster. At approximately 10:45pm, SCU members Mashpee Officer Michael Assad and Deputy Michael Huse observed the vehicle on Bumpus Road, Hyannis.

SCU Units stopped the vehicle on Bumpus Road, Hyannis. The operator was identified and from Brewster. The passenger was identified as Andrew V Pitts , age 23 of Hyannis. PITTS is very well known to the SCU and Cape Cod Law Enforcement. He is on Barnstable Superior Court probation for a 2010 stabbing of a Pufferbellies security person. PITTS had on his person ten (10) grams of heroin. He was placed under arrest for possession of heroin with intent to distribute and held on a \$2500 cash bail.

On 03/30/2013, Members of the SCU were working in the Main Street, Hyannis area. They observed a subject, later identified as Wesley M Jones, age 22, of Yarmouth, attempting to enter a Main Street, Hyannis bar. JONES appeared intoxicated and was belligerent to the bar staff. SCU members continued to watch JONES. They observed him enter a vehicle on Main Street. JONES appeared to rummage through the vehicle and then next exit it. He next attempted to enter two (2) additional vehicles. Based on their observations they encountered JONES. A follow up investigation revealed JNES entered first vehicle illegally. JONES and the vehicle's owner were not related . JONES had entered the first vehicle without owner permission. He was placed under arrest and charged with B&E motor vehicle. Following his arrest the SCU received a BOLO for the Yarmouth Police Department regarding JONES. He was identified as a suspect in a domestic dispute stabbing. At the time his arrest by SCU members, JONES had a knife on his person used in the Yarmouth stabbing.

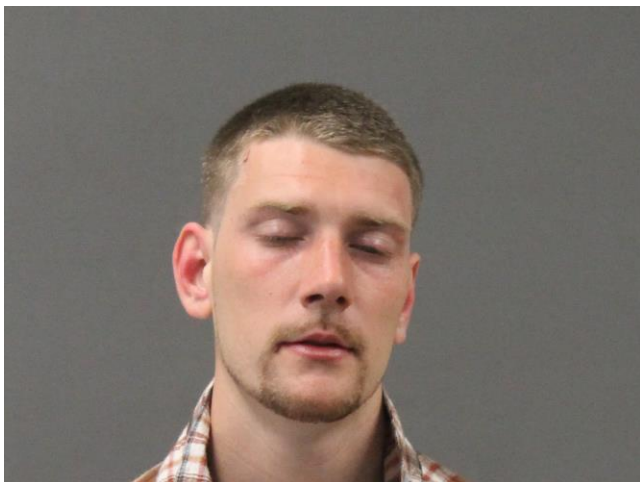
